## Eldorado National Forest Interpretive Association (ENFIA) Board Meeting Minutes June 18, 2025

- 1. On-line Zoom meeting opened by Stan at 9:05am. Quorum present.
- 2. Approval of Minutes from , 2025 meeting by majority vote of Board members.
- 3. USFS Report: Chris Sailor:
  - E-machine for parking passes ordered. Hopefully installed before 7/4.
  - Weekend patrols in and out in CPMA and Mokelumne Wilderness. Training volunteer patrols.
  - Crystal Basin visitor center is closed due to lack of staffing. Pacific District has asked if ENFIA can
    provide staffing two days per week. Fri/Sat or Sat/Sun. Huge need for public interface.
    Concern, per Stan, how many ENFIA docents have knowledge of area. Orientation/Training
    would be required. What inventory would be there for ENFIA sales? No permits. Handing
    maps etc. Concern about Crystal Basin drawing away from docents at CPIS. Send out notice
    asking about interests.
  - Water at Silver Lake should be online by next week. Campgrounds open 6/27. All other campgrounds open. All have water.
  - Removal of downed wood at CPIS? Later this year.
- 4.. President's Report Stan Trevena:
- Has application for California Alpine Club grant. Need to list all prior grants. Bookkeeper is working to compile info. Small amounts left from prior grants.
- Working to upgrade weather terminal inside CPIS. \$350.
- Previously talked about getting a generator. Great to power up the batteries in case of late season storm. Per Mike B. Electrical system upgrades are working really well. Upgrade included adding an outdoor jack to plug in a back up generator. Currently the batteries are full charged up the next day even after inclement weather. However batteries are fairly new and will degrade over time. Having a propane powered portable generator would be plug and play and good for the whole system, Per Stan the generator is an item to be included on the grant request due by the 30th.
- Stan question to Chris Sailor: Snow removal hitting the station. Any way to redirect? Answer not really possible. Reason for ask: Request to Volcano Telecomm for DSL to station during winter but the lightning that took out the e-machine for parking fees fried the lines 5 miles back and Volcano is having to secure permits to replace. Discussed keeping starlink system on during winter but the antenna is hit by snow removal. Not a good idea due to possible theft of antenna or damage from snow blowing. Frank T. notes that ENFIA has a good relationship with CalTrans from prior snow blowing issues. Still not a good idea to have antenna on roof during winter. Need to think about options there.
- Offseason possible projects at Silver Lake. Discussion: Edi if it has everything it need for now then no changes /adds for now. Do a survey at end of season for feedback on what may be needed. Upper bunkbed could use rails for safety, Rails available for cheap on Amazon and could be added.

- Training went pretty well. Stan and Edi put together a quiz for those 8 or 9 people who couldn't make training. Gotten a few back already. Edi opens up scheduling to persons who have completed forms.
- Suggestion that the guiz be used at the end of formal docent training seasons.

- Stan notes the the ENFIA Google drive has a very large capacity.

Need to address aging Square terminals. Currently using old iPad which will need to be replaced.
  - Contact with new company custom printing shirts. By next week should have prototype of shirts and get shirts just in time for full bloom. Flowers and "Eldorado National Forest" on shirt. Zoom group approved.

  - Electrical project completed and working well. Outlets working. Lights in loft working with timer switch. Plug in for generator added. Solar panels are charging batteries.
